Maternity redevelopment project overview

The new maternity ward is a \$7.1m investment in the health of our patients and their babies, now and for generations into the future.

The new maternity ward will help St John of God Geelong Hospital to build on our reputation for delivering outstanding, personalised maternity care in a number of ways:

- Generous sized patient bedrooms fitted out with stylish and contemporary design elements, double beds and day beds, with partners able to stay overnight
- Private ensuites and an option for in-room baby bathing
- · Family lounge
- Lift lobby and lounge
- Healing baths
- Specialised equipment
- A specialised maternity outpatient centre







Delivering on the promise of outstanding, personalised care

For many of our patients, St John of God Geelong Hospital is where life begins, and giving birth at our hospital has become a tradition for generations of families. We are fortunate to maintain a lifelona connection with mothers, fathers, children and their siblings.

Continuity of care

Our model of care is unique and personalised to each of our expectant mothers - who are cared for by their chosen obstetrician. It is this guaranteed continuity of care that ensures our parents foster a greater connection with their chosen physician, and promotes confidence as they navigate their journey into parenthood.

Trusted and highly skilled midwives and obstetricians

Our highly skilled and trusted midwives share their knowledge and skills with expectant and new parents, supporting them to ensure theu are equipped with all the information they need to care for their newborn baby. Many of our midwives have worked for decades at our hospital, providing support to generations of families and their babies

Specialised maternity outpatient centre and mental health support

Our specialised maternity outpatient centre will provide education programs including lactation support, infant vaccinations and fetal monitoring for mothers prior to delivery. Parent education programs will support parents during pregnancy, birth and into the early stages of parenting. Community-based mental health support is also offered through St John of God Raphael Services for mothers and partners, as well as access and referrals to additional support including paediatric consultants, physiotherapists, child health nurses, and parenting support.

Overnight staus for partners

Double beds and comfortable day-beds in patient rooms will enable families to bond in their first few hours and days of being together. The opportunity to stay overnight provides precious bonding time, and parents are able to focus their attention on their new babu, with the days and nights shared not only between mum and baby, but with their partner too.

Room service

New mums and their partners will be able to order their meals from our new room service menu, which means that meals are delivered on demand at a time that suits parents. We pride ourselves on our restaurant style menu and understand the importance that food plays in the health, wellbeing and recovery of our patients. Our new menu features a delicious selection of meals and snacks that have been carefully designed in conjunction with chefs and dietitians.
